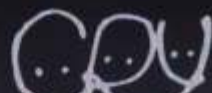

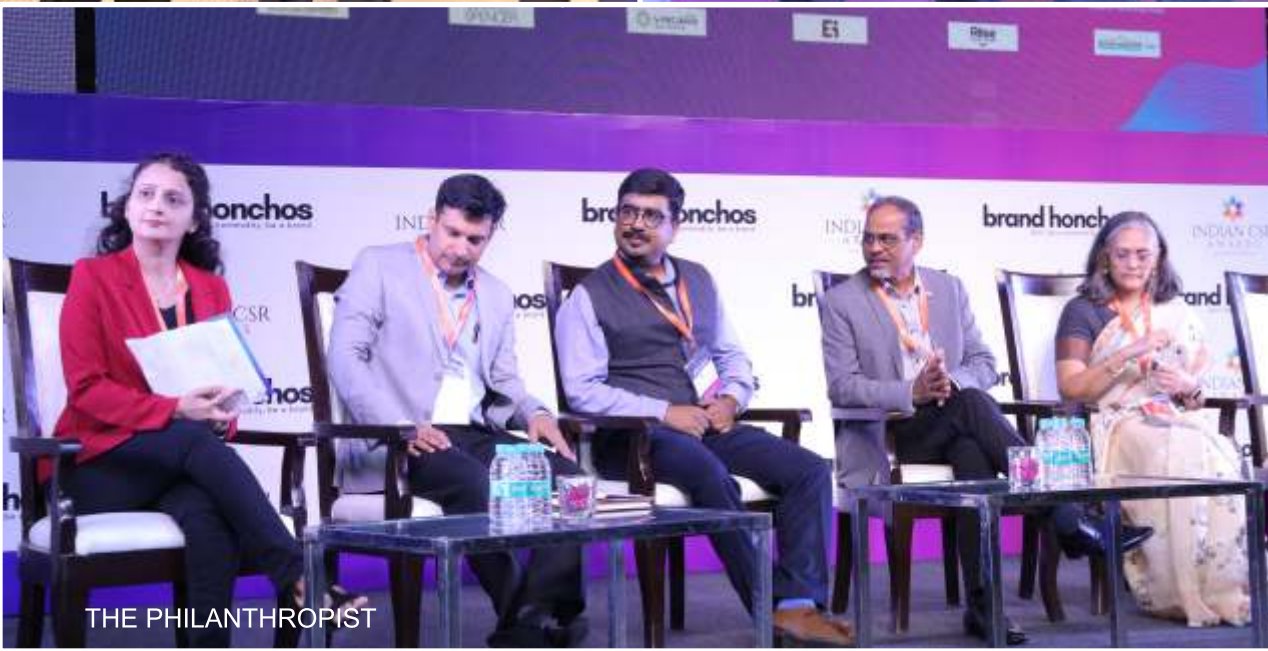

Founded in 1868, as a trading company, the Tata Group boomed as a multi-faceted industry dealing in energy, automotive, engineering, and information technology. A Padma Bhushan and Padma Vibhushan awardee, India's highest civilian honors, Shri Ratan Tata has played an instrumental role in transforming this Indian-centric company into a global business conglomerate that operates in more than 100 nations across the world. But this business tycoon has become the pride and icon of India for his magnanimous philanthropic endeavors. His contribution toward education, eradicating malnutrition, and nurturing the start-up culture, has made huge strides in shaping the face of modern India. Ratan Tata has been personally involved in the mission to alleviate poverty, making staple foods available for all, focusing on maternal health, and uplifting the people below the poverty line. He strongly believes that providing the right nutrition to

children and pregnant mothers is the key to uplifting the mental and physical health of the country. In addition to aiding the downtrodden, Ratan Tata is also actively involved in supporting education, medicine, and rural development. He invests more than 65% of his shares in charitable trusts. He endowed \$28 million Tata Scholarship Fund to Cornell University to provide financial aid to undergraduate students from India. In 2010, the Tata Group donated \$50 million for the construction of an executive center at Harvard Business School. In 2014, he made a generous donation of ₹950 million to IIT, Bombay. Apart from the company's notable contributions toward education and development, the humble entrepreneur goes above and beyond to make a difference in every life that he comes across. A rare gem of the special breed, Mr. Ratan Tata is an inspiration, an icon, and a legend who has enlightened this path of philanthropy and motivated many to follow this philosophy of giving back!



Sudha Murthy

A force that changed
the face of India



A prolific writer, engineer, professor, public speaker, and philanthropist, Sudha Murthy is a woman of rare treasure. A beam of light to a million souls, a ray of hope for the poor, and a pathfinder for the women in a deep-rooted patriarchal society, Sudha Murthy is a legendary woman who has paved the road to success for many future generations to come. Smashing the glass ceilings at a time when a woman's life was chained to the kitchen, Sudha Murthy went on to become the first female engineer to be hired by TELCO, India's largest auto manufacturer, which had an 'only-male' employee policy until then. A woman of rare grit, Sudha Murthy overcame every challenge she faced on this unexplored road with courage and resilience whilst nurturing warmth in her heart that was about to melt the world into a better place.

Sudha Murthy began her philanthropic journey in 1996 with the establishment of Infosys Foundation on December 6th. She deeply believed that philanthropy is not only about donating money for a cause but contributing to the cause in a way that actually makes a difference in people's life. For her philanthropy was about compassion and passion and so she chose the causes that were close to her heart, like public hygiene, healthcare, with a burning desire to see the country in its true glory education, art and culture, and poverty alleviation. Coming from a time when there was no lady's toilet in her college,

she understood the importance of hygienic public toilets. This inspired Mrs. Murthy to contribute to constructing 16,000 toilets across India. Education has always been very dear to her heart, and this led her to contribute towards building 7000 libraries in schools, introducing computer facilities in schools, and establishing several scholarship programs. She also founded several orphanages, participated in rural development efforts, and contributed to the fight against natural calamities, healthcare, and infrastructure.

Azim Premji, the founder and chairman of the tech giant Wipro, is one of the world's wealthiest and most benevolent business tycoons. Crowned as one of Asia's top philanthropists, the Czar of India's IT industry, Azim Premji has not only transformed his family's business from a humble venture dealing in vegetable oil into one of the biggest global business conglomerates, but he has also changed the face of Philanthropy in India. Premji established the Azim Premji Foundation in 2001, the non-profit wing focused on enhancing education in India. He deeply believes that education is the only vehicle that can drive positive social change. After piloting the company to humongous success, Azim Premji, with an astute vision and leadership has driven the non-profit organization to mounting heights. The organization began its journey with the purpose of bringing quality education to rural India and it has thus far worked with over 3,50,000 schools across seven Indian states. After a decade of groundwork in uplifting elementary education in India, Premji identified the challenges that children faced in pursuing higher studies. This led to the establishment of the Azim Premji University which contributed to the education sector through its advanced courses and scholarships.

This one-of-a-kind University in India also focuses on uplifting livelihoods, health, governance, and sustainability which contribute to building a better nation. Red with the Padma Vibhushan, India's second highest civilian award. Apart from education, the Azim Premji Foundation has collaborated with different organizations to drive a positive change by working on the fronts of gender equality, child care, mental and physical disability, and poverty.

He is also the first Indian billionaire to sign the Giving Pledge, an initiative by Bill Gates and Warren Buffet that encourages wealthy individuals to pledge half their fortunes to philanthropy. A billionaire by heart, Azim Premji donated Rs. 9713 crores towards philanthropy in 2021 and Rs. 7904 crores in 2020.

Renowned for his charitable works, he is the first Indian recipient of the Faraday Medal. His philanthropic endeavors also won him honorary doctorates from the Michigan State University, Wesleyan University, and the Indian Institutes of Technology at Bombay, Roorkee, and Kharagpur, among others. He is also the recipient of the Republic of France's highest civilian award, Knight of the Legion of Honor and in January 2011, he was hono

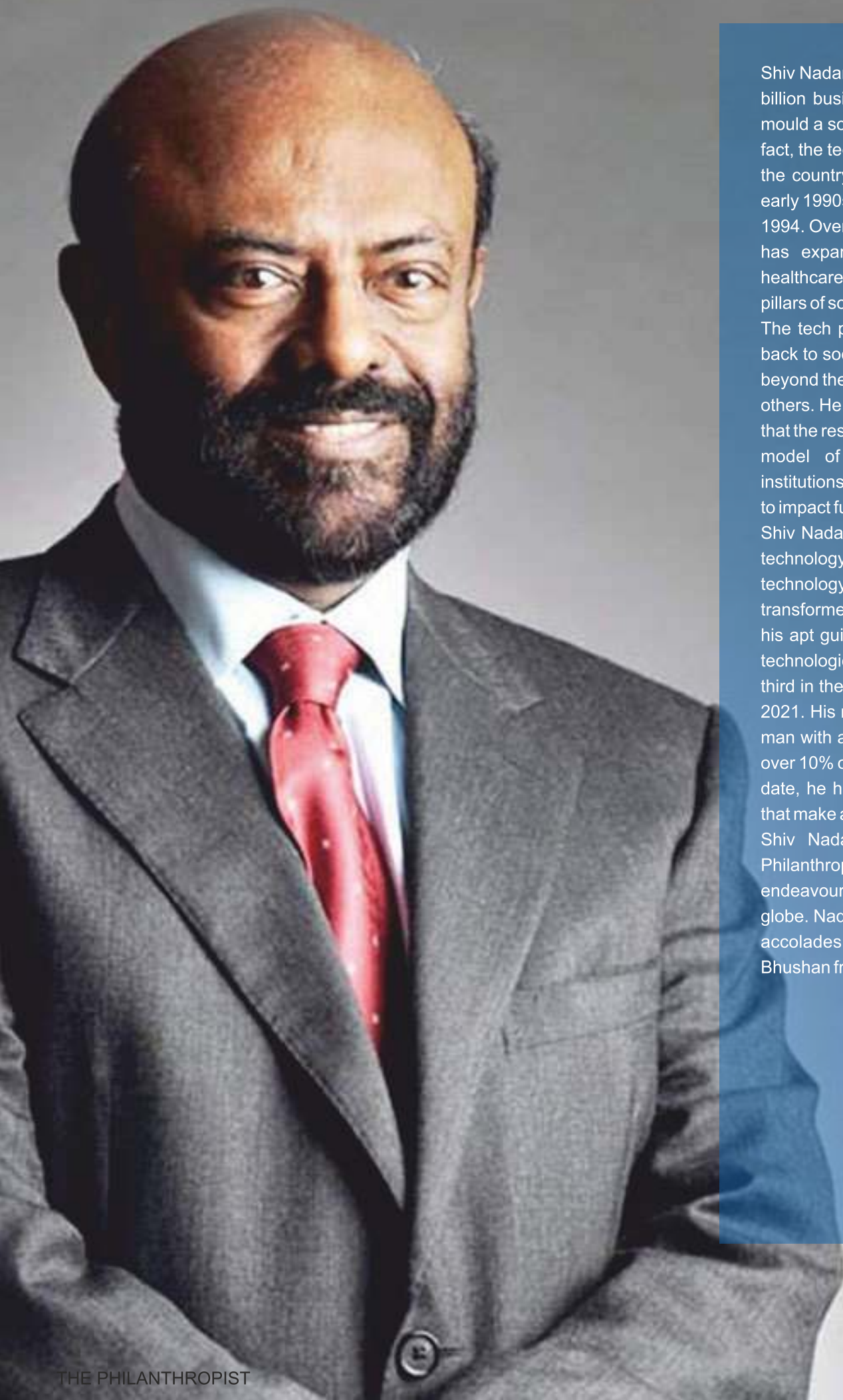

Annapoorna has been running one of India's leading morning nutrition program for rural school children working at the grass roots level in the area of child nutrition security and hunger management.

Today, Annapoorna provides morning nutrition to over 10,00,000 children across 23 States and Union Territories. These children attend government schools, located typically in rural hinterland. The morning nutrition may be in the form of cooked breakfast, Nutritious cookies, Raagi cereals health mix, or SaiSure nutrition supplement added to the milk.

Trust has formulated a health supplement mix (called SaiSure) which has been designed to specifically meet the protein, calorie, vitamin and mineral requirements, as well as micronutrients required for a growing child. The tasty and highly nutritious SaiSure health mix augments the milk provided by the government in the schools (part of their mid-day meals) and thereby makes it a wholesome meal for the children.

This product is certified by the FSSAI and is manufactured in a FDA-approved facility. This product is easily consumed by simply mixing it in milk and also easily transportable to remote geographies. It doesn't require expensive means of storage, and thus, is conveniently and economically scalable. All these services, which would have otherwise been expensive for the needy children's families, are rendered to the beneficiaries free of charge.

Various corporate companies participate in Annapoorna activities by sending their employees as volunteers on a regular basis to schools/centers that are being served by Annapoorna. These corporate volunteers visit a particular breakfast seva center/school(s) and spend time with the children engaging them in activities.

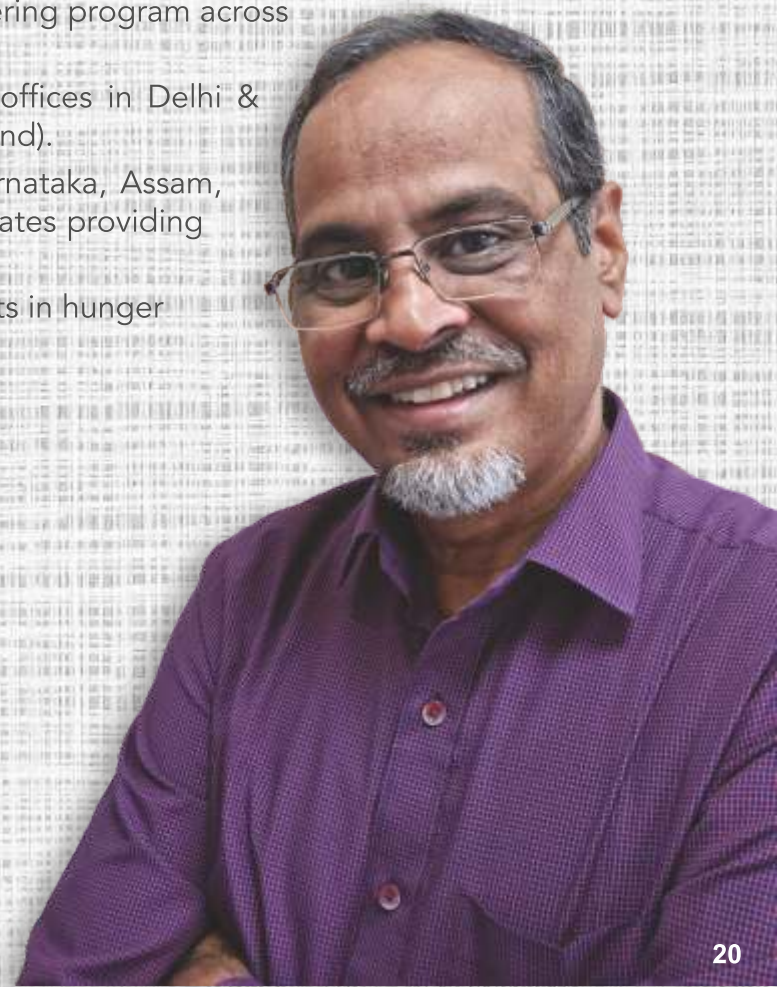

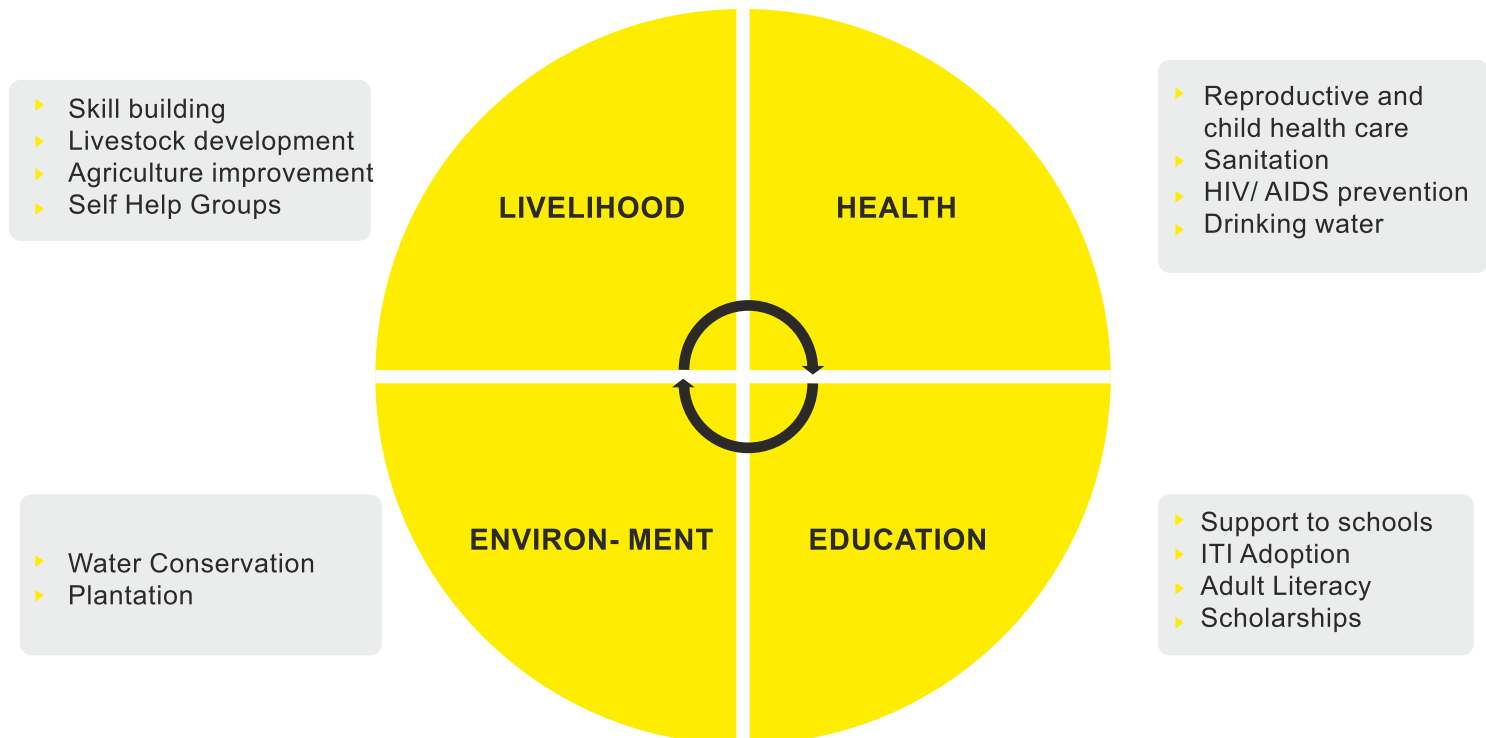


Corporate Social Responsibility at JK Tyre

While planning a CSR project or selecting beneficiaries, we lay emphasis on the interests of the marginal and vulnerable sections of society, women, the elderly, children and truck drivers.

CSR Focus areas of intervention



A Case Study: Livestock Development Programme at Morena, MP

Under this cattle breed improvement project, artificial insemination (AI) services are provided to produce calves with significantly higher milk yields, producing enough surplus that can be sold in the market. Livestock Development Centres in villages provide AI services right at the farmer's doorstep, which also include veterinary support to ensure proper health and nutrition. Surplus milk for sale generates extra income for poor households, which is often utilized to invest in growing the herd and creating dairying as a viable & profitable livelihood option.

During the last Six years of the livestock development program at 50+villages of Morena, MP, 31,699 artificial inseminations were performed, 9,010 hybrid calves were born and more than one lakh cattle were provided health care services (vaccination, deworming, de-ticking and fertility treatment). This project has brought transformational changes in the lives of more than 10,000 people and they are getting sustained additional income of 5,000-10,000 per month.

There are plans to encourage cattle-owner/milk producers' associations to reduce logistic costs and connect them to larger markets and derive higher prices.



India Vision Foundation is a voluntary not-for-profit organization registered as a Trust in India vide No. 4595 dated August 1, 1994. The foundation was born out of the Ramon Magsaysay award (Equivalent to Asia's Nobel Peace Prize) conferred to Dr. Kiran Bedi, the first lady IPS (Indian Police Services) of India,

Foundation aspires to contribute toward a crime-free society by initiating reformation programs for prison inmates and reintegration opportunities for released inmates for the reduction in recidivism; also facilitates welfare programs for their children to save them from becoming victims of their parental incarceration

Presently the India Vision Foundation runs different programs in nearly 37 Prisons across 8 States of India namely New Delhi, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Maharashtra, Uttarakhand, and Gujarat. Until March 2022, India Vision Foundation has reached out to 4,61,170 beneficiaries and continues to empower them through positive reinforcement, education, skills, and values thereby alleviating them from poverty and enhancing their chances of employability, and dissuading them from reoffending upon their release from prison.



Founded by Dr. Kiran Bedi along with 16 police officers, since our inception in 1988, we have been working seamlessly towards the upliftment of underprivileged sections of the society and providing marginalized groups with an opportunity to live a dignified life. Working at the grassroots level and adopting an integrated approach while focusing on planning interventions around education, skill training, women empowerment, environment, community training and outreach has helped us take substantial strides towards crime prevention. Our idea of crime prevention through social development is to foster interventions intended to reduce or eliminate the motives for the crime before they arise which we intend to facilitate by promoting skills and education among the underprivileged, micro-entrepreneurship, and livelihood for children and women, affected by the lack of resources. Serving as a laboratory of ideas, we help and foster the flow of thoughts and knowledge to aid communities to adopt better standards and envision a better life for the future generations ahead.
